

**Imlay City & Capac Paved Road Tour**

Join us in Imlay City for lunch at noon

Meet at the K-Mart parking lot south of Romeo on Van Dyke (between 30 Mile Rd and 31 Mile Rd) in time to leave by 9:30 am. If you're interested in breakfast there is a family restaurant across the street. And if you arrive early enough you can drive into Romeo for the annual Garage and Antique Sales.

After leaving from south of Romeo we'll travel through Armada, Richmond, Memphis and Capac on the way to Imlay City. Featured roads include Armada Ridge Road (east of Armada), and Belle River Road which is probably the best Model T road in Macomb County. Lunch will be in Imlay City at Nachos, a great family owned and operated Mexican Restaurant. Plan to arrive by noon.

After lunch we'll tour the Imlay City Historical Museum in the old depot and railroad cars. Next a short drive to Capac to visit the Capac Community Museum and see the restored, mechanical Kempf Model City. Built over seven years in Capac and finished in 1923, the Kempf Model City is 40 feet long. Then we'll head back to Romeo and an ice cream stop for those so inclined. The length is 80 miles on paved, scenic, rural roads.
